Using the net price calculator, you can find out your eligibility for financial aid from Wilberforce University and estimate your out-of-pocket expenses. The results from the net price calculator will show you how affordable Wilberforce University may be. The calculator is designed to give you an early indication of how much and what types of financial aid you might qualify for if you were a college freshman attending school full-time in the academic year indicated. It is a tool which we hope will give you a clear picture of options and opportunities so you can make more informed decisions about your college choices.

As you use the calculator, please remember:

1. This is not an application for admission or financial aid.
2. This is not your financial aid award letter.
3. The results will only be as reliable as the data you provide.
4. The net price calculator will only give you an estimate of your net price and aid eligibility. The financial aid office has the final word on your financial aid award.

When Awarded Financial Aid Is Not Enough to Pay Your Bill...You Have Options

- **A Parent PLUS Loan** is a common option for many families. It is a federal loan borrowed by parents of dependent undergraduate students to help pay for education expenses not covered by other financial aid up to the Cost of Attendance. A credit check is required at the time of application. PLUS application information will be sent with the official award letter.
- **Applying for scholarships** is always a good way to reduce your tuition bill, but if you start applying when the bill is due it might be too late. Start early looking.
 - Wilberforce is a **UNCF member institution**. Scholarship opportunities can be found at the UNCF website www.uncf.org/scholarships. Complete a profile and a general application (Must be updated each year). Any additional scholarship opportunities are emailed to the campus as they are received throughout the academic year.
 - Research and apply for scholarships from organizations in your community,
 - Each scholarship is different. You must meet the requirements of each scholarship to which you apply.
- **Payment Plans** are available through Nelnet Campus Commerce. Set up payment plans as early as possible for each term to have the lowest payment possible.
